CHRISTMAS EXHIBITION CONTINUES UPTURN IN SALES

After a busy autumn and start to the Winter Fine Art and Antiques Fairs we set about the presentation of our much coveted Christmas Exhibition. Preparations started back in October when Julie Haynes began the task of making the Homemade Canapés, chocolates and cakes. Forever the very proud achiever Julie set about an exciting menu to put in front of our valued clients; needless to say she did not disappoint. Many clients who made it to our preview left with not just a painting under their arm but also a take away box of goodies from Julie's table. Again she displayed her artistic flair with all the magnificent table decorations with a number of new additions making their first showing. All we can say is thank you very much Julie and very well done!

Needless to say that beyond the applause of our loyal following of clients we needed to make sales. As usual we were richly rewarded, with some sales yet to be concluded. In total we sold 29 works on the Saturday and 9 on the Sunday. Following the exhibition preview weekend we have sold through call backs another 11 high profile pieces with one very large deal pending. We quite naturally are ecstatic at the level of trade done but we hope this is a sign of things to come in the New Year. What was a recurring theme to most conversations was the lack of return on capital sitting in savings accounts and the lack of confidence to venture into alternative markets. The tangible value to art and the potential of a painting gaining in value was clearly the drive behind most of the purchases made. As we were clearly to gain by this thought process we were encouraging the discussions. After the opportunity to review the sales from the

exhibition and the last quarter we are confident that trade has changed for the better. As we have a lot of catching up to do with previous figures, our aim is to work hard in the New Year and encourage clients to seriously consider the opportunities within the Art Market. As to the direction of clients' preference of styles and period of art, we are left undecided. The sales pan out even across 19th to 21st Century paintings but we will keenly monitor both the auction and retail market over the coming year and keep you up to speed. There are some clear fashionable markets developing but these are mostly within decorative paintings which from experience end in tears. We will see.
